Special instructions: Rank candidates for mayor in order of choice.

- Fill in the number 1 oval (1) to the right of your 1st choice candidate.
- To select a 2nd choice, fill in the number 2 oval (2) to the right of that candidate.
- To select a 3rd choice, fill in the number 3 oval (3) to the right of that candidate, and so on.
- You may rank as many or as few candidates as you wish.
- Fill in no more than one oval per candidate.
- Fill in no more than one oval per column.
